There is an entrance fee of \$15 per person which can be applied to an annual membership if desired. If someone wishes to make the drive to the parking lot but not enter the Arboretum, there are nearby restaurants in Superior. (a list can be supplied)

The entrance fee entitles a person to be able to visit all of the features within the park.

The gathering spot will be at the Panera Restaurant just South of the Hwy 60 freeway at S. Signal Butte Road, about a ¼ mile on the West side of the road, just North of Baseline Rd. Meeting time is 7:30 A.M. and the drive will start at 8 A.M. Arrival at the Arboretum will be at approx. 9 A.M.
