Prescott was twice the capital of the Arizona Territory. First time between 1864 and 1867, and again from 1877 to 1899. There's a great selection of bars and restaurants in walking distance (bail money not included).

Saturday takes us on the second half of a great 356 twisty drive over Mingus Mountain, through Jerome, and on to Don Bell's house in Sedona for spectacular 360 degree views, a BBQ lunch (included) and an opportunity to inspect Don's own great collection of classic vehicles and race cars. This will be a real treat for Outlaws! Then it's off to the cool pines of Flagstaff for the Little America Hotel.
